- (vi) The region is important for the country's national security as well as international relations.
- (vii) The high-altitude wildlife in India today faces a variety of threats.
- (viii) The existing high altitude protected areas in India require considerable strengthening.

Project Snow Leopard was introduced in India by the Project Snow Leopard Committee instituted by the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India, in the year 2009 to safeguard and conserve India's unique natural heritage of high-altitude wildlife populations and their habitats by promoting conservation through participatory policies and actions.

Project Tiger and Project Elephant are prevalent in India with the former introduced in 1973 garnering worldwide attention.

The Snow Leopard usually occurs at an altitude of >2700m above sea level and is the apex predator in the Himalayan Region along with the Tibetan Wolf. The project is not only to protect the Snow Leopard, but as with Project Tiger, it is considered an umbrella species and with its protection, comes the protection of other species and the habitat which they are all a part of.
